Message from the Executive Headteacher

Dear Parents,

Our first full week back and everything has been quite settled. Thank you for your support working with the different start and finishes.

Please can I remind parents that children are welcome to bring snacks to school for breaktimes, but they are to be healthy ones. Children should not be eating chocolate or crisps or sandwiches. An extra box of snacks is not necessary, a piece of fruit is ideal.

All Pre School, Swan's and Robin's Class children have a variety of free fruit and vegetables provided for them so don't require to bring an additional snack. Also any additional drinks brought into school for lunchtimes should only be water. Squash is not necessary and the children can refill their bottles throughout the day. All children are provided with a school water bottle so an additional bottle is not necessary.

So finally, a reminder that we are a nut free school, we have children with serious allergies and we must keep them safe while at school. Please check your packed lunches to ensure they do not contain nuts items.
